Description

This position is for a self-motivated and committed licensed mental health provider. MHA has part-time, full-time and contract therapist positions available, providing counseling for adults, adolescents, children and families in an outpatient office setting. As a therapist in the MHA- WI Wellness Clinic you will conduct individual and group counseling sessions.

Additional tasks include:

Job Responsibilities

- Document clinical service delivery within 48 hours of seeing clients.
 - Maintain patient contact information and complete all required paperwork to ensure that clinical services are billed in a timely manner.
 - Assess, diagnose, treat and counsel patients
 - Perform psychosocial evaluations
 - Develop individualized treatment plans that define services and interventions
 - Update treatment plans according to documentation requirements
 - Maintaining the appropriate sized caseload to meet minimum productivity expectations
 - Attend outpatient staff meetings for updated agency communication, clinical consultation and training
 - Assist with coordinating the provision of other MHA services/programs as needed and identified in treatment plans
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Additional requirements for Therapist include:

- Master's degree in Human Services, Social Services or a related field
 - Valid license as an LPC, LCSW or PsyD in the state of Wisconsin
 - Experience providing mental health counseling to adults, adolescents and children
 - Provide clinical supervision to interns and support staff
 - Complete Prior Authorizations for all program participants
 - Coordinate the provision of services and data collection
 - Assist case management staff in evaluation of patient/client in weekly case consultation meetings
 - Oversee and ensure maintenance of client records on all clients.

 - A self-starter with excellent organizational and follow-through skills
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Requirements

- A minimum of 3000 post graduate hours and an independent license in Counseling (LPC), or Marriage and Family Therapy (LMFT), Psychology (PhD) or Social Work (LCSW), through the Wisconsin Department of Regulation & Licensing.
