

Mental Health Clinical Case Manager Strong Families Healthy Homes Program (SFHH)

MHA has an opportunity in our Strong Families Healthy Homes Program, which provides home visiting and community-based mental health services to adults and families living with serious mental illness. We are looking for applicants that have experience working with individuals and families with complex trauma histories.

Description: The clinical case manager position is responsible for ongoing engagement, assessment and service planning with clients to meet their mental health needs. The Clinical Case Manager works with an interdisciplinary team to support client's mental health and wellness goals as they move towards improved mental health and permanent connections. The Clinical Case Manager works in partnership with the Program Supervisor for continued program enhancement.

This is a full-time position that requires either a clinical license or training license in Professional Counseling or LPC-IT, Marriage and Family Therapy or LMFT-IT, Advanced Practice Social Work standing or APSW. Clinical supervision available for applicants working to earn 3000 post-graduate clinical hours. Applicants bilingual in Spanish and English strongly encouraged to apply. This position may also require in-home therapy and case management.

Core Job Functions

- Maintain 25 billable hours of client time weekly, **including outpatient therapy, case management and in home mental health services.**
- Provide assessment/intake, evaluation of family needs and treatment planning
- Oversee and ensure maintenance of your client records and progress notes
- Develop and facilitate groups for clients
- Attend weekly supervision and case consultation with supervisor and all weekly meetings as assigned

Additional Duties

- Responsible for billing outpatient time
- Complete prior authorizations for all outpatient therapy clients
- Provide reflective supervision and mental health consultation to contracted home visitation programs
- Provide support to 2-4 clinical mental health graduate school interns per semester
- Coordinate between other agency programs (Info & Referral, Outreach, Suicide Prevention)
- All other duties as assigned

- Knowledge and understanding of mental illness, the recovery philosophy and individual advocacy
- Be a self-starter with excellent organizational and follow-through skills
- Ability to assist with developing program areas as needed
