

Schizophrenia

A person with this can't think well. The person may see things that are not there. The person may not want to be around people.

Doctors do not know how people get this.

Signs of schizophrenia

A person with this may:

- See things that are not there.
- Feel like someone is watching them.
- Not care about things.
- Not do well in school or at work.
- Not clean themselves.
- Not want to be around other people.
- Act different.

If you have any of these for 2 weeks, get help. Most people who get this are 13 – 25 years old. Anyone can get this.

Kinds of schizophrenia

There are many different kinds of schizophrenia. Only a doctor can tell someone if they have this, or what kind they have.

Treatment
