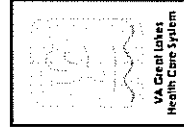

We are honored to welcome Veterans and Service Members who have recently returned from serving in combat operations such as Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF) and Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF).

We are committed to helping make each service member's transition from active duty military status to civilian life as smooth and seamless as possible.

The VA provides combat veterans with free health care for conditions potentially related to their combat service for up to two years following their separation from active duty. At the end of the two year period, veterans will retain enrollment eligibility. Co-pay status will be determined based on individual circumstances.
